PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT - NEWCASTLE SANTA CLAUS PARADE

SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2022

The Newcastle Santa Claus Parade's Mission Is to Celebrate the Spirit of Christmas by Providing a Safe, Enjoyable and Quality Family-Oriented Event on The Main Street of Newcastle, Ontario.

In order to make this event both entertaining and safe for all participants and spectators, **All parade participants must therefore agree to abide by the following terms and conditions:**

1. Although the route is well lit, this is a night-time parade and entrants should keep this in mind when designing their float, costumes etc. You are urged to illuminate your entries.
2. November weather is unpredictable; therefore, entries need to be adaptable and prepared for possible rain, snow, wind or even ice on the parade route.
3. Floats will be inspected upon arrival and must be approved by a designated parade committee representative. Floats that are deemed to be unsafe will not be permitted to participate.
4. The parade committee has final authority on the inclusion of any entry at its sole discretion.
5. Please note that if you plan to distribute treats (i.e., candy canes) to parade spectators, you must hand them to the recipients **AND DO NOT THROW THEM.**
6. Parade participants may not sell or offer for sale any commodity, service, food or drink on the day of the parade.
7. Canvassing or asking for donations is prohibited.
8. **Parade participants may not distribute commercial/advertising-based materials. Our parade is a "paper free" event - no paper handouts, coupons etc. are to be handed out during the parade. This reduces the litter on the street and is environmentally friendly.**
9. For safety reasons, no parade participants may jump on or off the float or moving vehicle, and may not interfere with any other unit in the parade.
10. Vehicles that are not an integral part of carrying out a group's parade theme may not accompany the group/unit along the parade route.
11. The floats are **NOT** to be of a **rolling advertising billboard nature**. Sponsorship signage should be secondary to the title of the float. 2022 Theme: CHRISTMAS TOY LAND
12. All animal entries must have a person following behind with cleanup equipment.
13. The official parade Santa Claus is the only Santa Claus allowed in the parade.
14. Failure to abide by this agreement may result in removal from the parade formation and/or not being accepted for participation in future parades.
15. Please be advised that the Newcastle Santa Claus Parade may be professionally video taped for archival purposes.
